



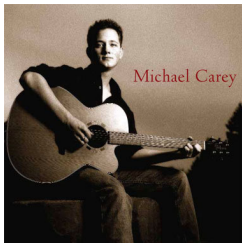

We are pleased to have Randy Bachman grace our outdoor stage for Solstice Festival 2005. Randy is a legendary figure in the rock and roll world through his talents as a guitarist, songwriter, performer and producer. His songwriting has garnered him the coveted #1 spot on radio play lists in over 20 countries and he has amassed over 40 million records sold. His songs have been recorded by numerous other artists and placed in dozens of television, movie and commercial soundtracks. His music has provided a veritable soundtrack of the last thirty years of popular music.

Randy scored Billboard radio chart success with his band The Guess Who in 1965 performing the song *Shakin' All Over*. The Guess Who went on to virtually own the pop charts with an unprecedented run of 5 million-selling singles, all the product of the gold plated Randy Bachman-Burton Cummings songwriting team. Their hits included *These Eyes, Laughing, Undun, No Time, No Sugar Tonight* and *American Woman*.

Randy left The Guess Who and formed Brave Belt - a country/rock outfit in 1970 and experimented with a new musical style and line up that eventually metamorphosized into Bachman Turner Overdrive. Randy's success with BTO would eclipse his earlier triumphs with hits that included *Let it Ride, Roll on Down The Highway, Takin' Care of Business* and *You Ain't Seen Nothin' Yet*. Randy Bachman continues to be in much demand as a songwriter, session player and solo artist and we are looking forward to an amazing musical event in our Park.

GATE ADMISSION AND TICKET POLICY

Due to the anticipated interest in this event, our third annual Solstice Festival, we will be implementing the following policy towards gate admission. If you have any questions, please contact the Park at 271.7516.

Parkland residents, current with their annual fees, will be admitted to the Festival at no charge. Upon entry to the Park, residents aged 18 and over will be required to provide picture identification confirming their address, and a wrist band will be issued. Residents under the age of 17 may also attend the Festival at no charge, but they must be **accompanied** by an adult in order to be issued a wristband.

Guest tickets can be purchased by Parkland residents; **there will be a limit of 6 guest tickets per Parkland residence.** Guest tickets are \$10 in advance with a limited number to be available at the door at a cost of \$15 per ticket. It is essential that guest tickets be purchased by a Parkland resident either in advance or at the door; tickets will be exchanged for a wristband upon entry to the Park. *Tickets will not be sold to non-resident guests without being **accompanied** by a Parkland sponsor.*

Re-entry to the Park will be allowed, but only if the wristband is worn. It is a requirement that the wristband be worn at all times while attending any of the Solstice activities.

Advance ticket sales will take place the week before the Solstice Festival, as follows:

Saturday June 11	10:00 am – 2:00 pm
Monday June 13	6:00 pm – 8:00 pm
Tues 14 th / Wed 15 th / Thurs 16 th	9:00 am – 3:00 pm <i>-and-</i> 6:00pm – 9:00 pm
Friday June 17	No ticket sales / the Park is closed at 1:00 in order to accommodate private function.
